## ABOUT THE NEW TASK FORCE

Food authenticity is an emerging topic of concern. Recent cases of melamine addition to infant formula, addition of peanut to ground cumin, addition of illegal dyes to spice mixes are not only an indication of the frequency of incidents, but also of the severity, as all of the cases have related health issues and, in the case of melamine, even caused death of several infants and permanent injuries to thousands. To reduce the risk of such incidents, several activities have been started. On the traceability and auditing side, schemes have been amended to include specifically aspects of vulnerability assessment.
